Dear Parents/Carers

Thank you for your ongoing support during this most difficult period of the pandemic. Whilst schools remain closed for face to face learning, the number of Coronavirus cases are falling. The First Minister, Mark Drakeford, has announced that he is hopeful that some pupils will be able to return to school week commencing 15<sup>th</sup> March IF cases continue to fall. It appears that this will be **Year 11** in the first instance. Following that, we are hoping for a staggered return to school for all other year groups. We are still receiving and processing detailed information, although as previously announced there will not be formal external exams this year. Instead, these will be replaced by Centre Determined Grades. These will be based on all available evidence that we hold for your child.

Most pupils have submitted their option polls virtually. We are confident that most choices will be catered for and we will be in contact with pupils in due course to discuss the next steps. 












#### **Years 7 & 8**
